


MEASURING FROM A RING YOU OWN

1. Get a ring that fits perfectly on the finger on which you will wear your new ring.
2. Place your ring on the circle of the ring sizer below that is closest in diameter. The inner edge of the ring should be on the outer edge of the circle.
3. If the ring is between two sizes, we recommend choosing the larger size. For the record, an average size is between 52 and 53.



BEFORE PRINTING THIS GUIDE, PLEASE FOLLOW THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS:

- Check in the print settings that the “Scale to paper” option is set to “No”.
 - The ring sizer must be printed on an entire A4 sheet.
- To check that the ring sizer has been correctly printed, measure using a ruler that the scale below measures 5 cm.
